*American Commonwealth*, Bryce, 2 vols. Interesting and invaluable.

*Canadian Annual Review*, Hopkins. The volume for each year gives an excellent account of public events.

*Letters of Queen Victoria*, 3 vols.

*Life of Gladstone*, Morley, 2 vols.
