HUNGER STRIKERS IN CRITICAL STATE CAN HARDLY SPEAK

Father of Young Man Has Withdrawn Permission for Nuns to Feed Him.

VISIT OF ARCHBISHOP

Cork, Sept. 12.—Seven of the eleven hunger strikers in Cork jail appeared today to be in critical condition. They are Sean Hennessy, the 19-year-old youth; Joseph Murphy, whose status as a citizen of the United States is being investigated; Thomas Donovan, Michael Burke, Upton, Bower and Kenny.

Hennessy still was unconscious today, and the others were so weak that they were hardly able to articulate. Murphy has a troublesome cough, which he refuses to permit the doctors or nuns to do anything to alleviate.

NO STAY IN ORDER GRANTING INCREASE IN RAILWAY RATES

Government Declines to Interfere—Higher Fares Effective Today.

OFFICIAL STATEMENT

Ottawa, Sept. 12.—(By Canadian Press)—The Dominion government in an official statement handed out tonight declines to grant a stay in the order of the board of railway commissioners granting the Canadian railways the right of increasing their freight, passenger and sleeping car rates. The order goes into effect tomorrow. The statement says that the decisions of the railway board cannot be lightly interfered with, and that since the board has been in operation, no judgment of the board has been set aside by the government in council.
