Resolution No. 1.

Moved by Stanley Manitowaba,
Seconded by Peter Judge,

That Chief Alfred Tabobandung be given a permit to cut fuelwood to sell. 50 cords (single). Dues at .50 per cubic cord to be returned for credit of Band funds.

Resolution No. 2.

Seconded by Stanley Manitowaba

That Leonard Walker be given a permit to cut fuelwood to sell. 10 cubic cords. Dues at .50¢ per cubic cord to be returned for credit of Band funds.

Resolution No. 3.

That Anderson Tabobandung be given a permit to cut fuelwood to sell. 50 single cords. Dues at .50¢ per cu. cord to be returned for credit of Band funds.

Resolution No. 4.

That Elijah Tabobandung be given a permit to cut 25 single cords of wood to sell. Dues at .50¢ per cord to be returned for credit of Band funds.

Resolution No. 5.

That John Miller be given a permit to cut 300 hemlock logs. Dues at \$5.50 per M. ft.

Resolution No. 6.

That Joe Pegahmagabow be given a permit to cut 800 cedar posts. Dues at .02¢ each to be returned for credit of Band funds.
