COMMENT ON STOCK MARKET

A Sustained Rise Cannot Be Accomplished -- The Money Situation.

(New York Journal of Commerce July

The true character of the stock mar was revealed yesterday when, after a m terial advance fostered by the temper government report on the Harriman so-called "strong hands" that are carrying awkwardly large lines of stock sought liquidate surreptitiously. The whole lis promptly gave way, and by three o'cloc gains of 1 to 3 points had been almos wiped out. The market is evidently no so situated that a sustained rise can be accomplished, for not only would inside let out stocks in large quantity, but the money market would in itself prove a ser ous barrier. On the other hand the mo powerful interests in the financial distr ve little to gain from lower prices at they, therefore, refrain from bringi about a collapse. They are anxious to s securities but not to sacrifice them. T hour caused tentative optimists modify their earlier predictions, and l night sentiment was mixed, the more co servative houses being of the opinion th while moderate improvement may take place during the next month, circum stances are not yet ripe for a wild can

Enthusiasm over a return to cheap money was chilled by a rise of 1-4c. per pound in demand sterling. Should money become still easier on call, it is by no means certain that gold will not again go to Europe. The Bank of England is losing no opportunity to strengthen its resources, especially as the chancellor of the exchequer has intimated that unless the banks of the country take steps to build up reserves, the government may take action. Moreover, the shortness and lateness of European crops suggest that London may be called upon to send a good deal of gold to this country in the autumn. Yesterday the bank secured about \$2,000,000 new gold, the Bank of France
