At the last annual meeting of this Society the name was changed to the Home Missionary Association, to avoid confusion with the Woman's Foreign Missionary Society.

The Association held twelve meetings during the year and four quarterly Sales, realizing in all \$12670. By special agreement the money made during the June Sale was applied to furnishing the platform of the Church with chairs, table, font, and necessaries for the baptismal service. The rest of the money made during the year was evenly divided, according to the Constitution, between the Missions of the Church and improvements in Church property. The objects this year selected being the Bursary Fund and repairs to the Manse

The funds now in hand, for improvements in Church property made by Congregational Sales, amount to \$399.17, and is lying at interest in the Banking House of Donald Fraser, Esq. The Society, aided by a few friends of the Congregation, had an inscription placed on Dr. Machar's monument in memory of the late revered Mrs. Machar.
