

BUSINESS FOR NEXT SESSION.

Motion by Rev. T. H. Appleby, on paying the expenses of the Clergy and Lay Representatives. (Min. 12, Sess., p. 344.)

Notice is hereby given that at the next meeting of the Synod the undersigned will move that authority be obtained from the Provincial Synod to allow one Bishop to permit, when necessary, the Clergy to shorten or divide the Services of the Church.

Synod

1. The Synod Clergy duly licensed not under ecclesiastical authority as hereinafter provided.
2. Clergymen who have become superannuated shall retain all the rights and privileges of the Clergy.
3. The Lay Representatives shall have one year's standing in the Synod, by each duodecimarius number, at a meeting of the wardens of each congregation; a member of the congregation shall subscribe his name to the roll of England and Ireland, and his nomination; and shall be eligible for the election of Lay Representatives.
4. The Incumbent of each congregation and in their absence the warden shall be present.
5. The number of representatives of each congregation, one; when they exceed one hundred, two; and when they exceed two hundred, three; it shall be the duty of the warden to give notice of the names of all those who are disqualified, and the names of all those who are qualified.
6. Each Representative shall be the chairman of the meeting.
