The Rules here referred to, are

RULE 17. "THAT the Clergy and other Members of the Society be requested to enquire generally within their respective Parishes what want there is of Bibles, New Testaments, and Common Prayer Books; and where a deficiency is found, to promote Parochial subscriptions for the purpose of obtaining a supply of these and other publications of the Society.

RULE 18. THAT, in furtherance of the object referred to in the preceding Resolution, the officiating Clergy be respectfully requested to recommend this Society as occasion shall require, (on the first Sundays of the months of July or August) and in such way as they shall deem most adviseable, to the benevolence of their respective Parishes; and that they be further requested after this recommendation, to make a collection or adopt what other measures they shall deem most likely to prove successful, for obtaining Donations for the immediate supply of their own local necessities."

It is obvious that although particular Sundays are mentioned in the last regulation, any other days may be substituted, according to the discretion of the Clergyman:
