By substituting Spiral Springs, as shown in
the engraving, with suitable mechanism to convey
pressure to the tools in place of the elliptic spring
formerly used, a straight stroke of the tools
is obtained, adding greatly to the value of the
machine, especially in setting out.

Another improvement, represented above, is
that is known as "The Holmes Patent Sta-

tionary Handle." By this method of oper-
ating the slide brakes, in lifting and lowering the
tools an inexperienced person may readily ac-
quire the knowledge of operating the machine,
the handle being stationary while the engine is
in motion. This improvement is very simple
and readily applied by the operator, and is uni-
versally preferred even by those accustomed to
the old style handle. A similar handle is used
for operating the brush, although not shown
in the cut.

The machine has also been more perfectly
balanced than ever before, so that it can be used

in upper
stories of
buildings,
if necessary,
without the
use formerly
experienced.

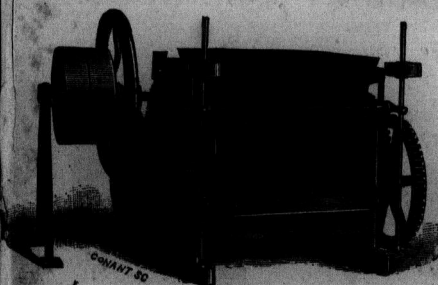

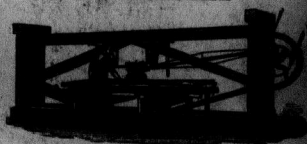
