The retiring Moderator intimated that his term of office had expired, thanked the Synod for the honour conferred upon him in calling him to the chair, for the courtesy shown him during the year, and the cordial support given throughout his term of office, and requested the Synod to proceed to the appointment of his successor. On motion of Dr. King, seconded by Mr. Farquharson, it was unanimously agreed that Dr. Duval be Moderator of Synod for the ensuing year. Dr. Duval, on being conducted to the chair, thanked the Synod for the confidence expressed by appointing him to the Moderatorship. It was agreed, on motion of Mr. Murray, seconded by Prof. Hart, that the thanks of the Synod are due and are hereby tendered to the Rev. Joseph Hogg for his conduct in the chair during the year, and for the sermon with which he opened this Synod. It was agreed on motion of Mr. Murray, seconded by Mr. Rumball, that the time of sederunts be as follows:

From 10 a.m., to 12 m.
2.30 p.m., to 5.30 p.m.
8 p.m., to 10 p.m.

And it was further agreed that the first hour to-morrow morning be spent in devotional exercises. The Clerk reported that the Committee on Bills and Overtures had not been able to meet and that no docket had been prepared, but that the Committee would report at the beginning of the next sederunt. Mr. Pitblado, convener of the Committee on Arrangements, reported that the Committee had arranged that Home and Foreign Missions would be considered Wednesday evening and Church Life and Work would be taken up Thursday evening, and that popular addresses on these subjects would be delivered. The Synod adjourned to meet at 10 o'clock to-morrow morning, the Moderator pronouncing the benediction.
