WAS CRUSHED TO DEATH Prof. H. M. Scott, D. D., of Chicago Theological Seminary, who, in former years, was well known in Halifax and throughout Eastern Nova Scotia, was crushed to death in Chicago on April 30, being caught between two cars in a blinding snow storm. He was born in Gaysboro and was graduated from Dalhousie in 1870 and then studied in Edinburgh and Germany.
