CLOSING LETTER

ON COTTON MARKET

(F. B. McCURDY &amp; CO.)

New York, Nov. 10.—The market has been somewhat nervous and irregular today, but on the whole has shown a steadier tone on trade buying and covering. The opening was steady at an advance of 2 to 9 points net and active months sold 8 to 10 points net higher. Night after the call. Prices then broke under renewed liquidation, Southern selling, and bear pressure with active months making new low contracts sold off to 12 1/2 or a cent a pound under the recent high record. Just below 13 cents for the spring.

There was a good demand from trade sources and the market steadied up on the buying of this kind covering with covering. Trading was less active during the afternoon, but the tone was steady at an advance of 13 to 17 points from the closing figures of Saturday. There has been nothing in the news to create any fresh sentiment regarding the size of the crop or the trade outlook.
