Mr. Speaker: The question is now on motion No. 3, Mr. MacDonald (Egmont):

That Bill C-202, an act to provide incentives for the development of productive employment opportunities in regions of Canada determined to require special measures to facilitate economic expansion and social adjustment, be amended, by deleting paragraph (b) of clause 4 and substituting therefor:

(b) In the case of a proposal to establish a new facility or to expand an existing facility to enable the manufacturing or processing of a product not previously manufactured or processed in the operation or to expand an existing tourist or service operation, a secondary development incentive by way of additional financial assistance to the applicant for the establishment of the new facility or the expansion of the existing facility for that purpose.

Mr. G. H. Aiken (Parry Sound-Muskoka): Mr. Speaker, as this amendment is consequent upon the amendment which has just been defeated on a recorded vote, we would request that a standing vote not be taken.

Mr. Speaker: Is this agreed?

Some hon. Members: Agreed.

Mr. Speaker: Hon. members have heard the motion. All those in favour of the said motion will please say yea.

Some hon. Members: Yea.

Mr. Speaker: All those opposed will please say nay.

"(c) the establishment of a Crown corporation in consultation with provincial authorities would make a more significant contribution to economic expansion and social adjustment within the designated region."
