The cost of the publication of such a catalogue would be partly defrayed by the sale of individual copies and by grants which we ought to obtain from the other Canadian Institutions which are interested. McGill, of course, ought to bear proportionately a large share, but this would be a small amount in any case and negligible in comparison with the results in publicity and scientific value.

I shall be glad to call at your office at your convenience to talk over the matter in greater detail should you regard this suggestion with favour. Though a large amount of the preliminary work has already been done by the Bureau, an early start on the details of organization of the different Institutions involved would be highly desirable.
