The Fishery Act.

HEREAS it is expedient to make better provision for the preamble. preservation and regulation of the fisheries of this Province: Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, 5 enacts, as follows:

- 1.-1. The Act Ninth George the Fourth, Chapter Fifty- Acts and parts of Acts repealone;
 - 2. The Act Fourth and Fifth Victoria, Chapter Thirty-six;
 - 3. The Act Seventh Victoria, Chapter Thirteen;
- 10 4. The Act Sixteenth Victoria, Chapter Ninety-two;
 - 5. The Seventh paragraph of the Nineteenth Section of the Act Eighteenth Victoria, Chapter One hundred;
 - 6. The Act Eighteenth Victoria, Chapter One hundred and Fourteen;
- 15 7. The Act of Sixth William the Fourth, Chapter Fifteen;
 - S. The Act Eighth Victoria, Chapter Forty-seven;
 - 9. The Sixtieth, Sixty-seventh and One hundred and Sixth Sections of the Act Twelfth Victoria, Chapter eighty-one
- 20 Are hereby repealed.
 - II. No provision of laws repealed by any Act cited in the next Acts repealed preceding Section shall revive by the repeal of the said Laws. not to revive.
- III. Notwithstanding the repeal of the Acts enumerated in Repeal not to Section one, every act done, and every right acquired by virtue affect penal-25 of the said Acts shall remain valid; every penalty incurred ties incurred, shall remain recoverable; and every legal proceeding commenced may be continued as if the said Acts were not repealed.

IV. The Governor may, as occasion shall require, appoint Two Superintwo Superintendents of Fisheries, one for Upper and one for tendents of Fisheries to be Lower Canada, whose powers and duties shall be defined appointed. by this Act and the regulations to be made under it.
