C A P. XIX.

An Act for enabling His Majesty to raise the Sum of One Million for the Uses and Purposes therein mentioned; and for further appropriating the Supplies granted in this Session of Parliament; and for exempting any Annuities or Sums of Money granted or to be granted to the Royal Family, from Payment of Taxes.

WE, Your Majesty's most dutiful ^{Preamble.} and loyal Subjects, the Commons of Great Britain, in Parliament assembled, having taken into our serious Consideration Your Majesty's most gracious Message, signifying Your Majesty's Desire to be enabled by Your faithful Commons to defray any extraordinary Expences of the War incurred, or to be incurred, for the Service of the Year One thousand seven hundred and sixty one; and to take all such Measures as may be necessary to disappoint or defeat any Enterprizes or Designs of Your Majesty's Enemies, and as the Exigency of Affairs may require, have resolved to give and grant to Your Majesty the Sum of One Million for that Purpose; and do therefore most
