

BILL.

An Act to incorporate *The Neepigon Mining Company.*

WHEREAS the several persons hereinafter named have, by their Petition, represented that they have associated themselves together, with divers others, for the purpose of exploring for and working Mines of Copper and other ores, and of smelting the same on the shores of Lake Huron and elsewhere, by Articles of Agreement entered into at the City of Toronto, the eighth November, one thousand eight hundred and forty-seven, and have raised by subscription the capital necessary effectually to begin their operations, but that they experience great difficulties in carrying out the objects for which they are associated without an Act incorporating them with the powers hereinafter mentioned, and have prayed that such Act may be passed: Be it therefore enacted, &c.

And be it hereby enacted, by the authority of the same, That George K. Smith, John W. Telford, Benjamin F. Hedges, Wm. L. Newbold, Jacob Stockman, John L. Newbold, George Wood, H. B. Pennock, John W. Neal, Wm. C. Chace, Jos. H. Hedges, P. Maguire, Jos. H. Duckett, John S. Wood, and John Frs. Smith, and their successors and such and so many other persons or parties as have become, or shall become shareholders in the Capital Stock hereinafter mentioned, shall be and they are hereby constituted a Body Politic and Corporate, in fact and in name by the name of *The Neepigon Mining Company*, and by that name shall and may sue and be sued, implead and be impleaded, answer and be answered unto, in all Courts of Law or Equity whatsoever, and shall have uninterrupted succession with a Common Seal,
