

a time which shall be appointed by the Governors or Benchers of the said Community or Corporation or a majority of them, for that purpose, Public Notice of the same being by them given, of at least                      weeks, previous to such General Assembly, in the Quebec Gazette, and in one of the Public Newspapers printed and published at the City of Montreal.

V. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that the said Community or Corporation, when convened in any General Assembly as aforesaid, shall be, and the same is hereby authorised and empowered from time to time, and at all times, under the inspection of the visitors above mentioned, to make such By-Laws, Rules and Regulations, as may, by the said General Assembly, be judged conducive to the purposes of this Act, and for the promotion of learning and integrity in the persons admitted to the practice of the Law, in any of His Majesty's Courts of Civil Jurisdiction in this Province, and the said By-Laws, Rules and Regulations to abrogate, alter or amend, as need be, from time to time, and others in their room, to substitute as occasion may require.

VI. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that the General Assemblies of the said Community or Corporation, after the first General Assembly as aforesaid, shall consist of the aforesaid Governors or Benchers, and Members, or as many of them as can be convened at the time and place to be fixed for holding such General Assembly. Provided always, that such General Assembly shall not consist of less than                      Members of the said Community or Corporation, of which                      Members, His Majesty's Attorney-General or Solicitor-General or Advocate-General shall be one, or shall have been duly summoned to attend thereat.

VII. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that the said Community or Corporation shall have full power and authority to divide, form, and establish itself into as many sections as may be necessary, by reason of the different Districts where the Members thereof may severally reside, for the time being, each section to be distinguished by the name of the District for which it shall be formed and established, and the Justices of the Court of King's Bench, of the several Districts in this Province, shall be the visitors of the several sections of the said Community or Corporation in their respective Districts; and the                      senior Members belonging to the said Community or Corporation, in the Districts in which they respectively reside, shall be the Governors or Benchers of the section of the said Community or Corporation for the said District, and the said Governors or Benchers, or a majority of them,
