Re.Road Diversion Through Southern Portion of Indian Reserve No.58 Municipalities of Sifton and Woodworth.

A survey of the above Road Diversion is being made by Mr. R.J.Jephson D & M.L.S of Brandon, who found on the ground what appeared to be official posts marking legal subdivisions of sections through which this road runs.

If this is the case, will you kindly forward me copies of your official plans and field notes of the subdivision survey embracing Sections 28, 29, 30, 34, 35 and 36 all in Township 10 Range 23 W.P.M. being a portion of Indian Reserve Number 58.

This will materially assist the survey of this road. as the Surveyor is experiencing considerable difficulty on account of the obliteration of several mounds.

It occurres to me that the original section lines may no longer govern since the sections are included in the Indian Reserve in which event the road survey properly tied in actual boundaries of the Reserve itself should be sufficient Your advice on this matter will be appreciated.
