G.E. Irwin R219656, crashed on the main aerodrome as a result of having leveled off too high on a landing. The aircraft stalled as it was about to land and damaged a wing on the runway causing a cat. 'D7' crash. The pilot was uninjured.</p> <p>The 600 Air Cadets in the first camp are in the process of leaving this unit today after a ten day stay at No. 1 S.F.T.S. The Commanding Officer, G/C J.B. Harvey AFC, inspected the Cadets in the company of F/L Douglas, Cadet Commanding Officer, at 1330 hours.</p>
