The persons selected by the employes to represent them in conference with Mr. ______ will be the duly acceedited representatives of the employes at the Joint Meeting of the representatives of the employes of the Minnequa Works and the Quarry Camps with representatives of the Company, which it is proposed to hold in Pueblo during the month of January, for the purpose of discussing matters of mutual concern and of considering means of more effective co-operation in maintaining fair and friendly relations. They will also be the accredited representatives of the employes at all subsequent meetings and in all matters of co-operation between the Company and its employes, until the employes shall designate some other persons to represent them. It is, therefore, highly important that the employes choose with the utmost care those of their number in whom they have most confidence.
