- (B) with respect to apportionment of responsibility:
 - (i) The Dominion to be wholly responsible for navigation and all factors affecting navigation, including:
 - (a) Final dictation of the plan of overall development to be adopted (but by conferences between
 Dominion and Provincial Technical representatives,
 to make every effort to arrive at a mutually satisfactory scheme in the Ontario and the Quebec
 reaches respectively);
 - (b) The design of all navigation structures and of all structures necessary to navigation and for the basic features of the Power structures in so far as stability and provision for passage of water etc., etc., is concerned.
 - (ii) The Dominion to recognize the prior interest of the Provinces in the Power and to agree that:
 - (a) In the International or Ontario reach the development of the power to be in accord with the wishes of the Province of Ontario (i.e., by the Ontario Hydro-Electric Power Commission if the Ontario Government so decides);
 - (b) In the National or Quebec reach, the development of the power to be in accord with the wishes of the Province of Quebec (i.e., by license to private interests at the instance of the Quebec Government if that Government so desires).
 - (iii) The Provinces to be respectively responsible for the detailed design of the power houses:
 - (a) Ontario through the Ontario Hydro-Electric Power Commission;
 - (b) Quebec through its approval of the plans of private interests to whom licenses may be issued.
