Mr. Lelonde first. Most of the above are envious to get our work going in a more practical and useful way than has been the case, and this should be the main object of your trip. We should have a Committee at work which would direct the preparation of the lists in all the Montreal district. I mean a committee that would see that this is done and follow it up until it is done. I think you will find that arrangements are being made for several meetings. These meetings should be encouraged.

I think it would be well worth while to cell
on Mr. Zeph Hebert and Mr. Deslongohamps. There is a tremendous amount to do in Montreal and it is going to take a
really great effort to get things going and to keep them
going. This is where your greatest effort should be put
forward, and in your work you can depend upon my vigourous
co-operation.
