Sir,

With reference to my letter of the 25th June last and previous correspondence on the subject of the dispute between the Abenaki Indians and Felix Desforges, respecting the occupation by the latter of land on the Abenaki Indian Reserve, I have to inform you that the Department has been advised that Mr Desforges has offered to pay a rental for the land of \$15⁰⁰ per annum, and I have to request that, if you consider the offer sufficient, you will advise the Chiefs to accept it.
