
SIR:-

I beg to say that the Revd P. Leach, S.M.I., Teacher of the Roman Catholic Day School at Berens River, has made request to the Department for medicines for use on behalf of the Catholic Indians of the Reserve, and for the pupils of the school. The Department desires that you will order a small supply of drugs and have them sent to the teacher at Berens River, Man.

I may add that there are 54 Roman Catholic Indians on the reserve, and 23 pupils on the school roll, with an average attendance of 18.

I enclose copy of the teacher's letter so that you may know what he requires.
