Sir,-

On the 18th November the Department issues instructions to all Indian Agents to forward a list of the number of Indians who died from influenza. As there was a second outbreak of the disease at a number of the agencies, the Department desires to receive, without delay, another list, which should show the victime of the second outbreak, and which should indicate clearly the total number of deaths within your agency. In so far as you are able you should show the death rate in each band belonging to your agency.
