MEMORANDUM FOR MR. ROBERTSON

As I mentioned to you over the phone, the Prime Minister brought before Cabinet on Wednesday, February 12th, an urgent appeal for financial assistance in carrying on scientific work that had been made by the Montreal Neurological Institute. In this connection Dr. Penfield, the Director, had requested a personal interview to support these representations.

It was agreed:

(a) that, in view of the nature of the Institute's work, favourable consideration should be given to means by which assistance could be made available; and,

(b) that the Ministers of National Health and Welfare and National Revenue attend with the Prime Minister at his interview with the Director of the Institute.

I am returning herewith the material sent to us on this question and understand that your office will arrange to inform Mr. Martin and Dr. McCann as to attendance at the interview when its time and place has been agreed.
