For me personally, a great satisfaction to renew in Canada
the acquaintance with Mr. Curtin begun in London an acquaintance which time and events are fast
ripening into a friendship which, I hope and
believe, will be of benefit to both our countries,
to the British Commonwealth and to the United
Nations.
