up to Gidilude Smoke House, wide all along the valley
half up on mountain also with River and Creeks
as this land is our ancient Right, and the almighty
God has give to us to live on it and to do every
thing on, as if would find on Test of Proverbs. 22:28.
Read, Remove not the Ancient handmark which the
Fathers have set. So I am very sorry to tell you that
some of our People are falling off their Christian
living, as the good work of our late Missionary for
England, there do a great work off turning heathen
People into Christian life, so its just the work of
the department, now day, there are turning to heathen
way, as the Bills and Order, now day are against
the work on the Bible. I want to tell you this just
to let you know that we the Indians are not against
the department but there are against the our
Indians, and another question is how do we got to
live, no way to make our living we only work two
month every year on fishing, and if no fish come
who will help some of our People for living, will
the department will? no, we do the best, we can
almost ourselves collecting little food and give to who
