WHEREAS by Articles of Agreement dated the 21st day of February 1919 made between the Deputy Superintendent General of Indian Affairs representing the Indian Tribe on the Sliammon Indian Reserve of the First Part and AIEXANDER AIFRED PLUMMER, ROSS FEERS and ARTHUR MAVID ANDERSON hereinafter called PEERS ANDERSON AND PLUMMER of the Second Part the said Deputy Superintendent of Indian Affairs undertood to cut and deliver to the said Peers Anderson & Plummer all the merchantable timber on Harwood Island British Columbia for the price and upon the terms and subject to the conditions as more particularly therein set forth.

AND WHEREAS the said Alexander Alfred Plummer by Assignment in writing bearing date the 12th day of December 1921 did assign transfer set over and relinquish unto Ross Peers and Arthur David Anderson all his right title and interest in and to the said Articles of Agreement and in and to the timber thereinreferred to.

AND WHEREAS on the 13th day of December 1921 said Ross Peers and Arthur David Anderson by assignment in writing bearing date aforesaid did assign transfer set over and relinquish unto John A. Smith and Andrew John Anderson all their right title and interest in and to the said Articles of Agreement and in and to the timber therein referred to.

AND WHEREAS the parties of the first Part hereto are now the owners and entitled to the beneficial interests under said agreement.

AND WHIRMAS the Farty of the Second Part is desirous of purchasing the rights of the Parties of the First Part in and
