*Continued.*

Whereas a Treaty of Amity, Commerce and Navigation, consisting of fifteen Articles, was concluded between His Majesty the King of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, and the State of Colombia, which said Treaty, together with an Additional Article thereto, was signed at Bogotá on the 18th day of April, 1825.

His Majesty the King of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, and the State of Venezuela, the independence of which State is hereby acknowledged, recognized and declared by his said Majesty, mutually agree to adopt and confirm, as effectually as if the same were inserted word for word herein, the several Articles and provisions of the aforesaid Treaty concluded between his said Majesty and the State of Colombia, together with the aforesaid Additional Article thereto; and that all the matters and things contained in such Treaty and Additional Article shall *statim mutandis*, from and after the conclusion of the present Convention, be applied to the High Contracting Parties, their subjects and citizens, as effectually as if they were recited word for word herein; confirming and approving hereby all matters and things done or to be done, by their respective subjects and citizens, under the aforesaid Treaty, and in execution thereof. (Article I.)
