Height 158 feet - width 2376 feet. Sheet fo water in centre 20 foet thick. Amonnt of fater passing over every minute Thirteen hundfod and finy millions of cubic feet.

## TABLic ROCK

overhangs the caldron close to the Fall.
MUSEUM a few fout from Table Rock.
CLARKHILL ISLANDS AND BURNING gpring. Helf a mile from Table Ruck.

RAILWAY SUSPENSION BRIDGE. Two sllea below the Falls built by Great-Weatern 3. R. of Canada in 1855 is for both Railway sad Carriage une, 825 feet long, 200 feet above the water, depth of water underneath 250 feet.

THE WHIRLPOOL (See view). $81 / 4$ Miles boluw the Falls or $1 / 4$ beluw the Busp. Bridgeit was in trying to swim these Rapids and Whirlpool that Captain Webb came to an intimely end in 1883.

THE CANTILEVER BRIDGE. The only one of the kind in the world-built for the N. Y. Contral and Michigan Central Rall roads-opened Doc. 20/1883 and tested by 20 Locomotives and 9t Cars of Gravel. Ite location ia sbout 300 feet above the old Susperaion Bridge-spanning a Chasm 870 feet betwo the Blaffs and the Rails are 240 feet above 1 water. The Torers are of steel 182 feet on Stons Piers 89 feet high.

LUNDY'S LANE BATTLE GROUND $11 / 2 \mathrm{mi}-$ los west of the Fails. Battle of Lundy's Lame fought July 25th 1814.

BROCK'S MONUMENT seven miles below the Falls. Erected in 1858. Height 185 feet.

MgyOrANDA. Sam Patoh's leap 1829. "Maid of the Mist" jassed through the Whinipcol June 15th 1861. Francis Abbot (the hermit) rrowned June 1881. Blondin first crossed on tight rope 1859. The first white visitor Tethor Eennepin in 1678 . Rates of fare for carriages 1.50 per hour. The name "Niagars ${ }^{\circ}$ is a corraption of the Indian word ${ }^{\circ} \mathrm{Orya}$ arara ${ }^{\circ}$ maning "Ilighty, wauderful, thundering water.

## AMERICAN FALLS.

Height 164 feet. Width quarter of a mile - Amonut of water passing over every minute one handred and fifty million cabic feet.

## GOAT ISLAND GROUP.

Consisting of Goat Island. Bach Island. Luna Iniand. Terrapin Rocka. Three Siaters Inland. Hermits Cascude. Cave of the winds. Biddio-stairs dc. The Islands Contain over 60 acres and are Conzected with the Main-land and each other by anven bridgos. Goat Isiand is situsted at the brink of the precipice and separates the American from the Canadian Falls.

PROSPECT PARK.
Contains about seven acres and situated at the edge of the American Falls: The principal features of the park are Prospect Point, Ferry Honse and Inclined Rallway. Shadow, of the Bock. Brricane bridge. Ferry to Csnads. Electric uight and Art Gallery.

## NEW SUSPENSION BRIDGE.

For Carriages and foot passengere abont three fourths of a mile below the Falls-length 1268 feet and 100 feet above the water-depth of water andernesth 150 feet.

## WHIRLPOOL RAPIDS AND DOUBLE ELEVATOR.

$21 / 4$ miles below the Falls-width of River here only 300 feet and depth estimated 320 feet. Fally fifteen handred million Cubicfeet of water rush through this Gorge every Minute at the rate of nearly 30 miles an hour. A double Elevator - Coat 20000 Dollars and worked by water power - convoye visitora from ebove to the water edge.
