

CLYDESDALES FOR QUEBEC. Mr. George L. Stewart, Howick, Que-

bec, has bought from Mr. Thos. R. M'Lagan, Williamston, Crieff, the threeyear-old Clydesdale colt, Pratis Fashion (12692), bred by Mr. Alex. Fair, Pratis, Leven, and by the well-known Fickle Fashion (10546), out of a very good mare by the Glasgow winner, Moneycorn. This is a big, thick-bodied young horse of fine dark color. Along with him goes Mr. M'Lagan's dark-brown two-year-old, Midas (12677), by Battle Axe (10984), out of Jean of Pictston, by Royal Signet (8967). This colt was commended at the Royal Northern Spring Show. Mr. Stewart, who is to be back again by September, states that the black fouryear-old, Clan M'Leod (12099), which he secured through Mr. Williamson two seasons ago, is now one of the best horses in Canada. He was bred by Mr. William Watson, Downieken, Monifieth, his sire being Knight of Cowal (10074), and his dam, Love of Downieken (14445), by Brown Lawrence (9149). M'Leod was first at the Montreal Spring Show in a strong class. - [Scottish Farmer.


