Sheep by Wolves, to the great discouragement of the increase of that valuable stock.

Twenty fillings to be paid for each wolf, and ten fillings for each whelp, killed by an inhabitant—and ten faillings for each wolf, and five failings for each whelp, killed by an indian.

I. BE IT ENACTED, by the Lieutenant Governor, Council and Assembly, That from and after the publication of this act, a reward of twenty shillings shall be paid to any inhabitant of this province for each full grown Wolf he shall kill within the limits of the same, and ten shillings for each Wolf's whelp under a year old; and to every Indian ten shillings for every full grown Wolf, and five shillings for every Wolf's whelp under a year old which he shall kill within the limits aforesaid.

The head of every wolf killed to be brought to the nearest justice of the peace—

who, on being fatisfied that the person is entitled to the reward, shall disfigure the head and give a certificate to the Treasurer.

II. And be it further enacted, That who loever shall kill any wolf, wolves, their whelps, or whelp shall bring the head or heads of the same to one of His Majesty's Justices of the Peace within the county residing nearest to the place where the same shall be killed, who shall examine the party on oath (if he judge it necessary) and, on being satisfied of his being entitled to the reward, shall dissigne the head of the wolf or whelp by cutting off both the ears, and shall give under his hand and seal a certificate specifying the reward to which the party is entitled directed to the Treasurer of the province, or his deputy, in case any such deputy shall be resident in the county, who shall pay the same out of the monies belonging to the province Treasury: Which certificate shall be a sufficient voucher to the Treasurer for the money paid by virtue of this act.

## CAP. VI.

## An ACT to prevent the DESTRUCTION of SHEEP by DOGS.

If any dog shall kill sheep or lambs, the owner of the dog to cause him to be killed—

or be liable to pay for the sheep or lambs to be recovered before a justice of the peaceI. DE IT ENACTED, by the Lieutenant Governor, Council and Assembly, That if any dog or dogs
shall kill any sheep or lambs within this province, the owner
of such dog, upon complaint and conviction thereof before anyJustice of the Peace shall cause the same to be immediately
killed, or shall be liable to pay the owner of such sheep or
lambs the full value thereof to be recovered before any one of
His Majesty's Justices of the Peace in the county where
such offence shall be committed, who is hereby authorised
sinally to determine the same; PROVIDED the sum so to be recovered
