And Mr. Allsopp reported, that the Committee had come to a Resolution, which he was directed to submit to the House, whenever it shall be pleased to receive the same.

ORDERED, That the Report be now received.

And he read the Report in his place, and afterwards delivered it in at the Clerk's Table, where the said Resolution was again read, and is as followeth :

RESOLVED, As the opinion of this Committee, that it is expedient to establish a Table of Fees, for the Officers of the Courts of Civil and Criminal Jurisdiction within this Province.

On motion of Mr. A. Stuart, seconded by Mr. Ogden,

RESOLVED, That this House doth concur with the Committee, in the said Resolution.

On motion of Mr. A. Stuart, seconded by Mr. Ogden,

- **RESOLVED**, That the Table of Fees transmitted to this House, be referred to a Committee of five Members, with power to send for persons, papers and records, and to report with all convenient speed.
- ORDERED, That Mr. A. Stuart, Mr. Sherwood, Mr. Ogden, Mr. Viger, and Mr. Cuvillier, do compose the said Committee.
