1-Sweep ceilings, side walls, stall partitions, floors and other surfaces

2-Remove all accumulations of filth by scraping; and if woodwork has become decayed porous or ab conditions. It is the beginning of sorbent, it should be removed, burn ed and replaced with new material. 3-If floor is of earth, remove four inches from the surface; and in places where it shows staining with urine, a sufficient depth should be removed to expose fresh earth.
