Hospia Post-Graduate Course is given for Practitioners during June of each year. This course consists of daily lectures and clinics as well as demonstrations in the recent advances in Medicine and Surgery, and laboratory courses in Clinical Bacteriology, Clinical Chemistry, Microscopy, etc.

DIPLOMAS OF PUBLIC HEALTH—A course for branduates in Medicine and Public Health Officers of from six to twelve months' duration. This course is entirely practical and includes, in addition to Bacteriology and Sanitary Chemistry, a course on Practical Sanitation.

Hoertrals—The Royal Victoria, the Montreal General Hospital and the Montreal Maternity Hospital are utilized for the purposes of Clinical Instruction. The physicians and surgeons connected with these are the clinical professors of the University.

These two general hospitals have a capacity of 250 beds each, and upwards of 30,000 patients received treatment in the outdoor department of the Montreal General Hospital alone last year.
