Miscellaneous.

POT-PLANTS intended for winter flowering should be potted early. Small young plants are better than the large ones.

APPLE PANCAKES.—Two cups of sweet milk, one egg, four tablespoonfuls of sugar, one-half teaspoonful of salt, and flour enough to make a little thicker than griddles; two good sized apples pleasantly sour, pare and slice into the batter; drop into boiling lard. Very nice for lunch.

VELVET SPONGE CAKE.—Beat four eggs and two cupfuls of sugar well together, add two cupfuls flour, two teaspoonfuls of baking powder, flavour with lemon, and, lastly, two-thirds of a cupful of boiling water, just as it is ready for the oven, and although the cake seems thin, it is excellent.

ZEPHYRS.—Heat two cupfuls of boiled honey, adding sufficient water to make it thin enough to pour. Add a piece of butter as large as an English walnut, and a little salt. Have ready iron gem-pans, heated very hot, and well buttered. Fill these with the honey, and bake half an hour in a hot oven.

CHAIR covers (or slips) are very pretty made of brown crash, and worked with worsteds. Work each chair a different design. One with poppy leaves, another acorn and oak leaves, a third scarlet geranium, a fourth with roses. Then another might be embroidered with birds such as a swan, a thrush and nest.

GINGERBREAD.—Stir thoroughly into one cup molasses, four table-spoons hot shortening. Mix stiff with flour. Put one teaspoon each soda and ginger in coffee cup, filling the cup three-fourths full with boiling water. Stir this into the molasses, and if too thin, add a very little flour. Bake in dripping pan lined with greased paper.

A SIMPLE TOILET WATER.—Take of orange-flower water nineteen fluid ounces; best glycerine, one fluid ounce; borax, quarter of an ounce. Mix. This is an excellent skin preservative. It possesses the property of preventing scars occurring after burns or wounds, and even of removing of considerably reducing scars previously formed.

AN EXCELLENT SALVE FOR BURNS, ETC.—Canada balsam; beeswax; lard, aa. oz. ii. Melt those together and strain if necessary. In cold weather the proportion of oil may be increased, if necessary, to render it soft and easy to spread. This spread on cloth and applied to burns or other sores is very valuable.

IRISH STEW.—Cut in pieces one pound of mutton, half-stone of potatoes, a nice sized onion, pepper, salt and flour. Take a large sized dish, and cut the onion very fine into it. Pare the potatoes and cut into quarters. Fill the bottom of the dish, then add a layer of meat and a layer of potatoes until all are in. Sprinkle freely with flour, salt and pepper, and pour over enough boiling water to nearly cover the whole. Bake in a hot oven one and a half hours.

JELLIED CHICKEN. Boil a chicken in as little water as possible until the meat can easily be picked from the bones. Manage to have about a pint of liquor when done. Pick the meat from the bones in fair sized pieces, removing all gristle, skin and bone. Skim the fat from the liquor, add one ounce of butter, a little pepper and salt, and half a packet of gelatine. Put the cut-up chicken into a mould, wet with cold water; when the gelatine has dissolved pour the liquor hot over the chicken. Turn out when cold.
