Household Hints.

NUT CAKES.—One pound walnut meats chopped fine; one pound brown sugar; whites of four eggs; two table-spoonsful flour. Drop in small cakes on a greased pan, bake in slow oven. Hickory nuts will do as well.

FROZEN APRICOTS.—One can apricots mashed smooth; same can full of water; one pint sugar; one pint cream whipped and added when the mixture is partly frozen.

TOMATO MARMALADE.—Peel ripe tomatoes, cut them in small pieces and boil till done; rub through a sieve and add one cup of sugar for each cup of tomatoes; boil forty minutes, then pour into small jars.

TRAVELLING LUNCH.—Chop together sardines, ham and a few pickles; mix with mustard, pepper, capsic, salt and vinegar; spread between buttered bread. This is to be cut crosswise, like elly cake.

TOMATO SALAD.—Take nearly ripe tomatoes, slice in a dish and set on ice to get hard and firm, then just before using chop a large onion fine, and sprinkle over them, and add salt, vinegar and pepper to taste.

BREAD FOR SOUP.—Cut slices of stale bread in small squares, throw them in boiling lard and fry till brown. Skim out, drain and put in a soup tureen before serving the soup. For oyster soup, crackers crisped in the oven are nice.

SCALLOPED FISH.—One cold boiled fish flaked in small pieces. Boil to a custard. One pint milk, three eggs, three table-spoonsful butter, and one table-spoonful cornstarch. Mix with the fish and bake in dish in the oven half an hour.

GRAHAM PUDDING.—One and a half cups graham flour; sift and put back the bran; one-half cup common molasses; one cup milk; one cup raisins; one-half teaspoon salt; one teaspoon soda dissolved in a little milk. Steam three hours.

ICING FOR CHOCOLATE CAKE.—Three-quarters cup of Baker's chocolate melted; two cups sugar moistened in one half cup water, in which has been stirred one small table-spoonful cornstarch; lump of butter the size of an egg. Boil till it thickens—about five minutes. This will make enough for a cake of three large layers.

CHEESE SCALLOP.—Soak one cup of dry breadcrumbs in fresh milk; beat into it three eggs, and add one table-spoon of butter and a half pound of grated cheese; strew upon the top sifted bread crumbs, and bake in the oven a delicate brown.
