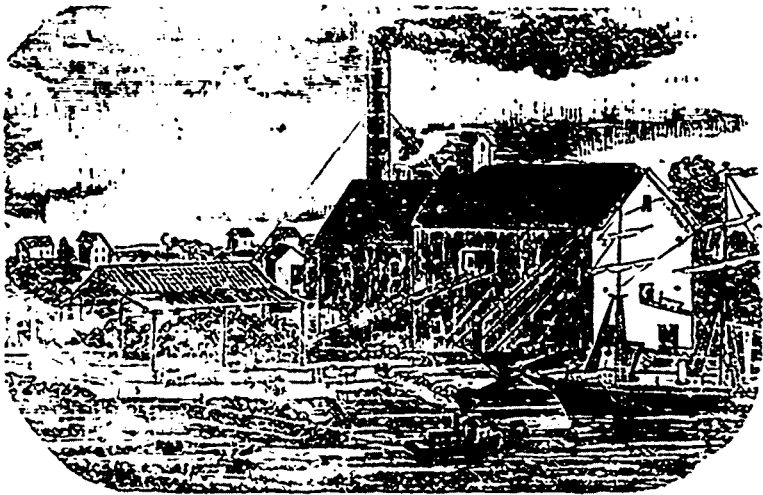

The 32 Calibre Winchester, now offered for the first time, is intended to meet a large and growing demand for a repeater of small calibre. It is a modification of the model of 1873, using the same frame, or receiver, but with a lighter barrel, and magazine of smaller diameter. It is considerably lighter than the Model of 1873, and is designed for small game at short range, and will be found the most accurate small-bore rifle in the market; especially valuable for hunting squirrels, geese, etc. The standard length of barrel is 24 inches. All the guns of this calibre will be made with rifle butt stock with solid butt plate, and without the cleaning-rod usually put in the neck. Prices and extras same as Model 1873. The cartridge used with this arm is centre fire, and contains 20 grains of powder and 115 grains of lead.

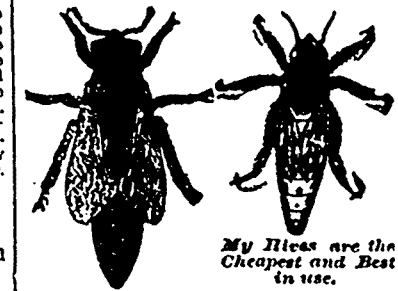
