THE COMET.

The comet which is nightly visible in the north-eastern part of the heavens, is not attracting much attention outside of astronomical circles, despite the alarm and fears of the superstitious portion of the community, as a rule accompanying the advent of these strange heavenly bodies.

Besides the actual observation of it by the naked eye, the comments of some of the most eminent astronomers of the continent are in-At the present time. Dr. Peters of Litchfield

Observatory, Hamilton College, Ohio, thinks that it is the comet seen by Lord Crawford, about 13 degrees from the sun, in Europe on June 9, and, on account of the position of the gode, it cannot be the comet of 1812, and still less that of 1808. At the Cambridge Observatory it is estimated that the comet is moving away from the earth at the rate of 300,000 miles a day. The nucleus is probably a thousand miles in diameter and the inner head twelve thousand, while the corona is vastly more.




