FLOUR.—The local enquiry is slow. Buyers hold off, and few sales have been made—250 brls. patent winter; \$5.40; 125 brls. do., \$5.25; 250 brls. straight roller, \$5.00; 250 do., at \$4.90; 125 extra at \$4.70; 125 at \$4.65; 125 superline, \$4.35; 125 brls. do., at \$4.25.

HOG PRODUCTS.—The demand is improved, while the supply in general lines calls for improvement. Prices are firm.

CHEESE.—The market is very quiet and prices remain unchanged. We quote:—3/4 c. 10c for finest and 6c @ 9c for fine; mediums bring from \$1.60 @ \$1.70; while the lower grades call for \$1.50 @ \$1.60.

BUTTER.—Buyers and sellers cannot agree. We quote:—Creameries, 18c @ 19c; Townships, 16c @ 18c; Western dairy, 15c @ 16c.

FARMERS' MARKETS. GRAIN.—Oats sell at from 70c @ 80c per bag; peas, 90c @ \$1 per bushel; buckwheat, 60c @ 70c do.; beans, \$1 @ \$1.50.

FRUIT.—Lemons, \$3.50 @ \$1 per box; oranges, \$5 @ \$5.50; the case; apples, \$1.50 @ \$2.50 per barrel; bananas, 70c @ \$1.00 per bunch; blue plums, 20c @ 25c per gal.; green plums, 20c @ 25c per gal.; blueberries, 20c do.; tomatoes, 15c @ 20c per bushel.
