

23. The Mexican side extended an invitation to Canadian artists, institutions, and cultural and artistic groups in the areas of dance, music, and the theatre to take part in the Festival Internacional Cervantino [International Cervantes Festival] (FIC), to be held in the fall of 1984, 1985, and 1986, in accordance with terms and conditions respecting the defrayal of costs as stipulated in this Programme.

For the Mexican side, the Culture Branch of the SEP will determine the details of Canada's participation in the festivals held during the period covered by the Programme.

In 1984, the FIC will receive the Claude Gervaise Ensemble, specialising in baroque music.

In 1985, the FIC wishes to receive a folk-music band.

In 1986, the FIC is interested in receiving a ballet company.

Canada will study the possibility of participating in the FIC in 1985 and 1986.

24. At Canada's invitation, Mexico will endeavour to participate in the public festivities taking place in Ontario to mark the 1984 Bicentennial.

The details will be determine through diplomatic channels.

25. At Canada's invitation, Mexico will endeavour to participate in the Expo '86 Cultural Festival to be held in Vancouver.

The details will be determined through diplomatic channels.

26. The two parties will exchange cultural promoters.

The numbers of people, the dates and durations of their visits, and other details will be established through diplomatic channels.
