The Department of External Affairs announced today that the Foreign Minister of the Republic of China, His Excellency Shen Chang-huan, will be arriving in Ottawa on February 24 for an informal visit, during which he will have consultations with the Secretary of State for External Affairs and other members of the Cabinet. Mr. Shen's two-day stay in Ottawa is part of a trip to Canada during which he plans to meet members of the Chinese communities in Montreal and Toronto.

Mr. Shen will arrive at Uplands Airport from Toronto at 4:15 p.m. on Wednesday, February 24. He will be met by the Honourable Paul Martin, Secretary of State for External Affairs, who will give a luncheon in his honour on Thursday, February 25. The Foreign Minister will also be received by the Prime Minister and other Cabinet Ministers during his stay in Ottawa. The Foreign Minister and his party will leave Ottawa for New York on Friday, February 26 at 3:50 p.m.
