PRAYERS

Two petitions for Private Bills were presented in accordance with Standing Order 67(1).

Mr. Portelance for Mr. Weatherhead, from the Standing Committee on Labour, Manpower and Immigration, presented the Third Report of the said Committee, which is as follows:

Pursuant to its Order of Reference of Wednesday, April 21, 1971, your Committee has considered Bill C-229, An Act respecting unemployment insurance in Canada and has agreed to report it with the following amendments:

Clause 3

Strike out line 13 on page 4 and substitute the following therefor:

'any policy force;'

Clause 4

Strike out paragraph (d) of subclause 2 on page 6 and substitute the following therefor:

"the employment of a person by a corporation if he or his spouse, individually or in combination, controls more than fifty percent of the voting shares of that corporation;"

Clause 26

Strike out lines 36 to 38 both inclusive, on page 14 and substitute the following therefor:

'respect of any time that falls in his waiting period, an amount not exceeding such earnings may, as prescribed, be deducted from the benefits'

Clause 30

Strike out line 17 on page 17 and substitute the following therefor:

'able for each week of unemployment in'

Clause 58

Strike out line 19 on page 33 and substitute the following therefor:

'under sections 49, 51 and 52 and any costs recovered against such persons;'

Clause 61

(a) Strike out lines 9 to 11 both inclusive on page 37 and substitute the following therefor:

'to the nearest multiple of five dollars or, if the result would be equidistant from two multiples of five dollars, to the mul-'; and
