Speech from the Throne, on the opening of parliament, 2. Sound reasons for believing that world is gradually returning to economic stability; improved world conditions reflected in Canada; visit of His Excellency to every province of the Dominion; beneficial results from the Ottawa trade agreements; extension of temporary trade arrangements with Germany and Austria; substantial improvement in prices of agricultural products; legislation designed to facilitate efficient and profitable marketing of live stock and agricultural products; participation of members of government in World Monetary and Economic conference in June of last year and adoption of certain resolutions dealing with monetary and

financial policies; legislation to be presented to parliament for the establishment of a central bank, extension of bank charters and further amendments to banking and monetary legislation; world wheat agreement for reduction of acreage under cultivation; high standing of Canada's credit reflected in successful loan flotation in the British market; establishment of agricultural short term and intermediate credits; assistance to the provinces to discharge their constitutional obligations; recent Dominion-provincial conference; approval by provinces of arrangements for care of single unemployed homeless men in relief camps and settlement of families on the land, 2; proposed promotion of employment by expenditures on essential public works and undertakings; measures to be presented relating to the Excise Act, the Companies Act, the Judges Act and the Elections Act, 3
