**Hon. J. R. Nicholson (Minister of Labour):**

it has been decided to adopt an interim policy that will permit the licensing of none but the very best of the individuals that have shown an interest in becoming trustees. It is expected that it will be possible to announce what this interim policy will be within the next two months or so. It may be added that there is no indication that the public interest has suffered in any way as a result of the lack of new appointees.

2. The decision not to appoint new trustees under the Bankruptcy Act was taken very shortly after the appointment of Mr. Roger Tassé as Superintendent of Bankruptcy in April of 1965.
