Considered in Committee; amended; reported, 525. Motion for third reading; amendments by Messrs. Blake and Foster; negatived; Bill read third time; passed, 546, 547. Passed by the Senate, 629. Royal Assent, 639.—47 Victoria, Chapter 14.
