

Memo to the Principal July 1933

The deficit on the Library,
\$77,000, is roughly about 30%
of our total annual deficit.

It is the salary list that takes
the bulk of the expense, not the
purchase of books.

In 1906 the Library had a gross
income or budget of barely \$13,000
for all purposes other than purchase
of books and periodicals.

In 1906 it had a staff of 10.

Today it has a total staff of 54
on the salary list alone and more
on the wages list.
