Want, being in, *n. abstr.*, kīmūk'itāppiisīnni. What do you want? kitak'sikipats; what does he want? kaii'uats.

War, *n. abstr.*, auakaw'tseisīnni.
v. recipr. They war, auakaw'tsciau.

War, go to, *v. int.* 3. Go to war, soo'āt; I go to war, nit'soo; he goes to war, soo'.

War, going to, *n. abstr.*, soo'sīnni.

Warm, *v. int.* 1. It is warm, amai'ksīstuyiū; ksīstutsīs'siū; soyīne'n.

v. reflect. Warm yourself, ksīstusu'yit; I warm myself, nitai'ksīstusuyi; he warms himself, ai'ksīstusuyiū.

v. t. ina. 2. Warm it, ksīstus-it'; I warm it, nitai'ksīstusip; he warms it, ai'ksīstusīmaie.

v. t. an. 1. Warm him, ksīstusīs'; I warm him, nitai'ksīstusau; he warms him, ai'ksīstusuyiuaie.

v. t. an. 1. Warm me, ksīstusuiats'okit; warm him, ksīstusuiats'is; I warm you, kitai'ksīstusuiatso; he warms him, ai'ksīstusuiatsiuaie.

Warming, *n. abstr.* (one's self), ksīstusu'yisīnni; (a third object), ksīstusūk'sīnni.

Warp, *v. impers.* It warps, emo'kōtsiū.

Wash, *v. reflect.* Wash yourself, issīs'tsīm musit; I wash myself, nit'ūs'sīsttsīm musi; he washes himself, ūs'sīsttsīm musiū.

v. reflect. (the face). Wash the face, issīs'kiosit; I wash the face, nit'ūs'sīskiosī; he washes the face, ūs'sīskiosīū.

v. t. an. 1. Wash my face, is-

sīs'kiokit; wash his face, issīs'kiīs; I wash your face, kit'ūs'sīskio; he washes his face, ūs-sīs'kiuaie.

v. t. an. 1. Wash my face, issīs'keīsttsīm mokit; wash his face, issīs'keīsttsīm mīs; I wash your face, kit'ūs'sīskeīsttsīm mo; he washes his face, ūs'sīskeīsttsīm miuaie.

Wash, *v. reflect.* (hands). Wash hands, isttsīm me'it; I wash hands, nit'ūs'tsīm mei; he washes his hands, ūs'tsīm meiū.

v. t. an. 1. Wash my hands, isttsīm me'atsokit; wash his hands, isttsīm me'atsīs; I wash your hands, kitai'isttsīm meatsō; he washes his hands, ūs'tsīm meatsiuaie.

v. int. 1 (clothes, floor, etc.). Wash thou, issīs'tsūtkit; I wash, nit'ūs'sīsttsūki; he washes, ūs-sīsttsūkiū.

v. t. ina. 3. Wash it, issīs'tsūttoat; I wash it, nit'ūs'sīststōp; he washes it, ūs'sīststōmaie.

v. t. an. 3. Wash for me, issīs'tsūt mokit; wash for him, issīs'tsūt mos; I wash for you, kit'ūs'sīststōmo; he washes for him, ūs'sīststōmo yiuaie.

Washing, *n. abstr.* (one's self), issīs'tsīm musīnni; (— face), issīs'kiosīnni; (— face for another), issīs'keīsttsūksīnni; (— hands for one's self), isttsīm me'isīnni; (— hands for another), isttsīm me'atsttsūksīnni; (clothes, etc.), issīs'tsūtksīnni.

Wash-basin, *n. an.*, itai'sūpsīskiosopi.

Wash-board, *n.*, itai'soksīsttsūkiopi.

Wash-tub, *n.*, it'ūs'sīsttsūkiopi

Waste, *v. t. ina.* 1. Waste it, ksīstuyet'sit; I waste it, nitai'ksīstuyetsip; he wastes it, ai'ksīstuyetsiuaie.

v. pass. ina. It is wasted, ai'ksīstuyetsip.
