- War, go to**, *v. int.* 3. Go to war, soo'āt; I go to war, nit'soo; he goes to war, soo'.
- War, going to**, *n. abstr.*, soo'sīnni.
- Warm**, *v. int.* 1. It is warm, a'mai'-ksīstuyiu; ksīstutisīsiu; soyne'u.
- v. reflect.* Warm yourself, ksīstusū'yit; I warm myself, nitai'-ksīstusuyi; he warms himself, ai'ksīstusuyiu.
- v. t. ina.* 2. Warm it, ksīstusit'; I warm it, nitai'ksīstusip; he warms it, ai'ksīstusūmai.
- v. t. an.* 1. Warm him, ksīstusis'; I warm him, nitai'ksīstusau; he warms him, ai'ksīstusuyuaie.
- v. t. an.* 1. Warm me, ksīstusuiats'okit; warm him, ksīstusuiats'is; I warm you, kitai'-ksīstusuiatso; he warms him, ai'ksīstusuiatsiuiae.
- Warming**, *n. abstr.* (one's self), ksīstusū'yisīnni; (a third object), ksīstusūk'sīnni.
- Warp**, *v. impers.* It warps, emo'-kōtsiu.
- Wash**, *v. reflect.* Wash yourself, issīs tsīm musit; I wash myself, nit'ūs'sīstīm musi; he washes himself, ūs'sīstīm musiu.
- v. reflect.* (the face). Wash the face, issīs'kiosit; I wash the face, nit'ūs'sīskiosi; he washes the face, ūs'sīskiosiu.
- v. t. an.* 1. Wash my face, is-
- sīs'kiokit; wash his face, issīs'-kiis; I wash your face, kitūs'-sīskio; he washes his face, ūs'-sīskiuiae.
- v. t. an.* 1. Wash my face, issīs'keītsīm mokit; wash his face, issīskeītsīm'mīs; I wash your face, kitūs'sīskeītsīm no; he washes his face, ūs'sīskeītsīm miuiae.

- v. int.* 1 (clothes, floor, etc.). Wash thou, issīsts'tūkit; I wash, nit'ūs'sīstsūki; he washes, ūs'sīstsūkiu.
- v. t. ina.* 3. Wash it, issīsts'-toat; I wash it, nit'ūs'sīsts top; he washes it, ūs'sīsts tomaie.

- Washing**, *n. abstr.* (one's self), issīs'tsīm muśīnni; (— face), issīs'kiosīnni; (— face for another), issīs'keītsūk'sīnni; (— hands for one's self), is tsīm me'isīnni; (— hands for another), is tsīm me'atsūk'sīnni; (clothes, etc.), issīsts'tūk'sīnni.
- Wash-basin**, *n. an.*, itai'sūp'sīskiosipi.
